

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING OF THE HIGHLANDS COUNTY  
CANVASSING BOARD TO BEGIN THE MANUAL AUDIT PERTAINING TO  
THE NOVEMBER 4, 2008 GENERAL ELECTION.**

Notice is hereby given that the Highlands County Canvassing Board will meet at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, November 21, 2008 to conduct a manual audit of a randomly selected precinct and race from the General Election that was held on November 4, 2008.

The meeting will begin at the Supervisor of Elections Office located at the Highlands County Government Center, 580 South Commerce Ave., Room A201, Sebring, Florida. If a larger room is needed to conduct the audit, the meeting will be moved at that time to a larger room. If a recess is needed during this meeting, it will be announced at the meeting.

The entire canvassing board procedure is open to the public and, if the meeting is held in the Supervisor of Elections Office, it may be viewed by the public via closed circuit television in the front lobby of the Supervisor of Elections Office in Room A201 at the Highlands County Government Center. If the meeting is moved to a larger location, the location will be large enough for public viewing.
